## Migrants and People Seeking Safety at Risk

President Donald Trump is implementing a mass deportation campaign targeting millions of migrants and people seeking safety. His **campaign violates multiple rights**, including protection against return to a country where people are at real risk of torture and other serious human rights harms (refoulement); the right to seek asylum; freedom from arbitrary detention; due process; family unity and children's rights; and non-discrimination. It also tears apart communities, families, and the economy,

The U.S. government has an obligation under international law to ensure that its laws, policies, and practices do not place migrants and people seeking safety at an increased risk of human rights abuses. The U.S., like all countries, has the power to regulate the entry and stay of non-nationals in its territory, it can only do so within the limits of its human rights obligations

We the undersigned call on you to obey and remain faithful to international law and practices and to protect the human rights of migrants and people seeking safety.
